Circumstances for Exemption from English Language Certification

C1 level or equivalent is the required level for entry into the Masters in Global Challenges for Sustainability. Applicants with B2 level will be considered in conjunction with other admission criteria but must attain C1 Level before programme registration.

Exemptions from English language requirements are available to applicants whose first language is English or who have been educated through the medium of English.
