8. COVID-19 considerations

We are aware that on a global scale, COVID-19 Restrictions vary. To ensure a space that values well-being and minimises stress or anxiety, we encourage you to make all the cautionary measures that you think are appropriate for yourself. Masks and disinfection spray/gel will be provided at the venue. Additionally, please, read the official information via https://visithungary.com/category/covid-19-information: *"The lifting of epidemiological entry restrictions means that from Monday 7 March 2022, travellers can enter Hungary without the need for vaccination or immunity certificates, or any kind of test or quarantine obligation. Simultaneously, lifting the special rules of access for certain services and events means that vaccination certificates are no longer required for entry to indoor congresses or conferences, accommodation establishments, spas, sporting or cultural events, music and dance festivals, or outdoor events of any kind. The wearing of masks in public spaces is no longer mandatory, although some venues may still recommend their use."*

9. Conference Hybrid Format

As described in the registration form, participating in the CHARM-EU Inclusion conference is free. The participant covers possible travel expenses. There is room for further improvement, but step by step, we aim to minimise structural barriers that hinder the access and participation of individuals. The hybrid conference is an example of applying multiple means of access and participation for participants in the event (In-person and online). We have chosen a more user-friendly, accessible, and inclusive online platform on many grounds. **Inclusion by design** means designing the environment from the beginning to the greatest extent of users (proactive) rather than a retrospective approach (fixing the environment afterwards). The hybrid feature is in line with the core values of CHARM-EU.

10. Access and participation in the venue

The building is accessible by public transport, including accessible public transportation, car, foot, and bicycle. The building venue is accessible, including elevators and accessible bathrooms. During the catering, we provide high and lower tables and chairs to cater for access and participation of the greatest number of participants. We will provide chairs for participants and session contributors inside the conference room. By not having a stage at our conference, we are breaking physical barriers and creating a space that cherishes partnership and collaboration between individuals. Environmental factors, such as changing weather conditions, may impact the conference. We will take necessary measures within our capacity for everyone's well-being.

11. Environmental awareness

Today, more than ever, being conscious of people and the environment is crucial. We want to lead by example and take step by step to create spaces and environments caring for the lives of today and the next generations and the most affected communities by climate change. We try to combine multiple means of accessible information to cater for access and participation of individuals while reducing unnecessary equipment and printing. We suggest considering and optimising your access and participation needs, financial aspects, and greener options for travelling.

We provide most materials in accessible online formats and via QR codes. We are conscious that in creating a space for active participation and engagement of everyone, we need certain conference materials. Restrooms, including accessible bathrooms, are located close to the elevators and stairs.














31. Access and participation in the online environment

Thank you for registering and participating in the hybrid conference. Here, we would like to share some information about the online facilities.

32. Access the online platform

- 1. **Conference Link:** You can join via the online conference link (the link(s)) will be directly sent to your e-mail address.
- 2. Access Zoom: It is not necessary to pre-install the Zoom program on your computer if you want to participate in a meeting because clicking on the link in the invitation should work, and the download will start automatically the first time you use it. Once the installation is complete, the Zoom login window will appear where you can choose to join a meeting (Join a Meeting)
- 3. **Installing (in case):** You can install the Zoom program on your computer in advance, so you no longer have to wait for the program to be installed when you are invited to the first meeting. You can download the Zoom program from the following locations: <u>https://zoom.us/support/download</u> or <u>https://zoom.us/client/latest/ZoomInstaller.exe</u>

33. Step by steps on how to join the online platform

- 1. Link to join: Click on the meeting link in the e-mail! You will receive two access codes: a link and an ID (Meeting ID).
- 2. Join a Meeting button /Launch the Meeting: Please, enter the meeting ID (MEETING ID) and the meeting password (PASSCODE)!
- 3. Your name: If the program asks for your name, please enter your preferred name.
- 4. Waiting room/Lobby: After logging in, you may have to wait until the following text is displayed: "Please wait until the organiser (host) starts the conversation."
- 5. Join Audio Conference by Computer: Please use the *"Join audio conference by Computer"* button If the organiser has started the meeting.

34. Zoom Platform Icons

During a discussion, you can find the microphone, video, and chat window interfaces in the lower left part of the screen (by moving the mouse). Below, we share the functions and **keyboard keys** to access the various icons.



1. **Sound/Microphone:** Click on the microphone icon on and off. A red cross indicates that you are switched off, which means no one can hear you.



2. Chat button: You can send a message to the participants by clicking the. The panel appears on the right.



3. **Camera:** To turn the video button on and off, click this sign. A red cross indicates that your camera is off, in which case no one can see it. In meeting controls, click on the video to be visible/invisible to other participants.

















4. Indication for speaking: In meeting controls: At Reactions, a hand appears in the lower bar, and there is a sign of raising hands which you can use to indicate that you want to speak.



5. **Break-out rooms:** CHARM-EU colleagues will assign you to be placed within different Break-out Rooms. Connection to space/room is automatically redirected to parallel sections JOIN ROOM. We will automatically redirect you to the joint space from the parallel sections, but the LEAVE ROOM button can also be used.

35. Keyboard shortcuts for Zoom

We have selected the most valuable shortcuts ordered by the operating system for easy finding. Just click your profile picture, then Settings, then Keyboard Shortcuts. If the defaults do not suit you, you can re-assign shortcuts in your Zoom desktop client for both PC and Mac.

38. The best Zoom keyboard shortcuts for iPadOS

The shortcuts for iPadOS are a little more limited; unfortunately, there is no push to talk with the space bar.

Command + Shift + A: Mute/unmute my audio

Command + Shift + V: Start/stop my video

- Command + Shift + H: Display/hide chat
- Command + Shift + M: Minimise meeting
- Command + U: Display/hide manage participants
- Command + W: Close the front window
